

**VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE
REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL
2020 MISC.CURB & GUTTER & CONCRETE FLATWORK REPLACEMENT**

You are invited by the Village of Bellevue, Brown County, Wisconsin to submit a proposal to remove and replace existing curb & gutter, sidewalk and driveway flatwork thru the Village. Work will be awarded as needed for the 2020 construction season. For an estimate on average amount of work please contact Greg Potts at gpotts@villageofbellevue.org or (920) 593-5518.

Proposals will be received by the Village until Thursday March 12th, 2020.

Proposals may be sent to the Village of Bellevue, 2828 Allouez Ave., Green Bay Wi. 54311. Attention Greg Potts.

Upon entering into a contract with the Village of Bellevue, insurance certificates and bonds representing the following must be presented by party submitting successful quote.

INSURANCE

1. The Contractor shall furnish the VILLAGE with proof of insurance in the amount as required by the approved specifications covering any public liability or property damage by reason of the operation of the Contractor, or Contractors' equipment, laborers, and hazard caused by said improvements. No construction (including grading) may start until proof of insurance is received. Insurance required is as follows:

1. Insurance Requirements

- Contractor shall procure and maintain for the duration of the contract insurance against claims for injuries to persons or damages to property which may arise from or in connection with performance of the work hereunder by the Contractor, his agents, representative, employees or subcontractors. The cost of such insurance is the Contractor's responsibility.

2. Minimum Scope of Insurance

- Coverage shall be at least as broad as: Insurance Services Office commercial general liability coverage, "occurrence" form CG 0001. Insurance Service Office form number CA 0001 covering automobile liability, code 1 "any auto" and endorsement CA 0025. Workers' compensation insurance, as

required in Wisconsin State Statutes, and employers liability insurance.

3. Minimum Limits of Insurance

Contractor shall maintain limits no less than general liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per occurrence for bodily injury, personal injury and property damage. A combination of primary and excess to meet this limit is acceptable. Automobile liability: \$1,000,000 combined single limit per accident for bodily injury and property damage. Workers' compensation and employers' liability: Workers' compensation limits as required by Wisconsin State Statutes and employer's liability limits of \$500,000 per accident.

4. Verification of Coverage

The Contractor shall furnish the VILLAGE with certificates of insurance as evidence of the required coverages. The certificates are to be on the form provided by the VILLAGE and must be received and approved by the VILLAGE before work commences. The VILLAGE reserves the right to require and the Contractor shall furnish complete, certified copies of all required insurance policies, at any time. The form of certificate is included in the Invitation for Bids for this project. The VILLAGE'S failure to notice or notify the Contractor of any coverage deficiencies that may be apparent in the documents submitted to the VILLAGE shall not relieve the Contractor of responsibility to provide coverages required in this contract.

5. The Contractor shall provide an Umbrella Liability Policy of:
TWO MILLION DOLLARS (\$2,000,000).

The cancellation clause on all certificates of insurance shall read as follows:

"Should any of the above described policies be cancelled before the expirations date thereof, the issuing company will mail 30 days written notice to the certificate holder named herein." (No modification to this clause will be accepted.)

SPECIFICATIONS**

Concrete

- Air- entrained concrete shall be prepared with Type I cement
- Concrete shall be Grade A.
- Compressive strength shall be 4,000 psi minimum in 28 Days

Reinforcement

- All point repairs and tie-ins to existing curb and gutter, dowel reinforcement into existing curb and gutter where repair is made.

Linseed Oil

- Furnish liquid membrane-forming curing compound composed of a blend of boiled linseed oil and high viscosity, heavy bodies linseed oil emulsified in a water solution conforming to ASSHTO M 148, Type 2, Class B.

Payment

- Remove, Replace, and restore Concrete Curb & Gutter, (Width), (Type) at Contract unit price measured in linear feet installed.
- Concrete Driveway/Sidewalk remove and replace will be paid by the square foot installed.

Traffic Control

- Traffic control devices (cones, barrels) to be supplied by the Village of Bellevue. A one-week notice (5 business days) to the Village of Bellevue Department of Public Works will be required prior to start of work.

Restoration

- Restoration and landscaping to be performed by the Village of Bellevue.
