RESOLUTION NO. V-13-2016
VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE

Resolution Amending the Official Floodplain Map of the Village of Bellevue for Parcels B-393-1587 and B-393-1589

SECTION A: GRANT AND DESCRIPTION.

Whereas, the Village of Bellevue has heretofore adopted an Official Map under the authority of §62.23(6)(b) Wis. Stats.; and

Whereas, said map shows the location of streets, highways, historic districts, waterways, parkways, parks laid out, adopted and established by law; and

Whereas, the Village of Bellevue has adopted Chapter 500-2100 Floodplain Regulations in accordance with requirements of participation in the National Flood Insurance Program; and

Whereas, Chapter 500-2100 Floodplain Regulations contains a list of adopted flood maps and flood studies; and

Whereas, BaKaBa LCC, has submitted a Letter of Map Revision Based on Fill (LOMR-F) for Parcels B-393-1587 and B-393-1589; and

Whereas, after considering the recommendations of the Plan Commission, and testimony received at Public Hearing on the 10th day of August, 2016, the Village Board finds that approval of this Floodplain Map Amendment would be consistent with the public interest;

Therefore, be it resolved, that the Village of Bellevue Board of Trustees pursuant to Chapter 500-200 of the Village of Bellevue Zoning Code, hereby approves the request for a Floodplain Map Amendment for property located at 1587 and 1589 River Pines Drive, Parcels B-393-1587 and B-393-1589.

SECTION B: MORE RESTRICTIVE PROVISION TO APPLY.

Where regulations contained herein are either more or less restrictive than comparable conditions imposed by provisions contained in this zoning ordinance, or any other law, ordinance, rule, resolution, or regulations, the requirements that are more restrictive or which impose a higher standard shall govern.

SECTION C: SEVERABILITY.

The several sections of this ordinance are declared to be severable. If any section, phrase, sentence, or portion of this Ordinance is for any reason adjudged to be invalid or unconstitutional by a court of competent jurisdiction, such portions shall be deemed a separate, distinct, and independent provision, and such decision shall not affect the validity of the remaining portions thereof.


SECTION D: ENFORCEMENT AND PENALTIES.

Any violation of the provisions of this ordinance by any person shall be unlawful and shall be referred to the municipal attorney who shall expeditiously prosecute all such violators. A violator shall, upon conviction, forfeit to the municipality a penalty in accordance with Village of Bellevue Municipal Code Chapter 1-4. Each day of continued violation shall constitute a separate offense. Every violation of this ordinance is a public nuisance and the creation may be enjoined and the maintenance may be abated by action at suit of the municipality, the state, or any citizen thereof pursuant to s. 87.30, Stats.


