

**VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE
RESOLUTION #V-29-2018**

**PRELIMINARY RESOLUTION DECLARING INTENT TO LEVY SPECIAL ASSESSMENTS
UNDER MUNICIPAL POWER PURSUANT TO §66.0703 WISCONSIN STATE STATUTES**

- **Casual Court (Jubilee Drive to cul-de-sac)**
- **Collier Court (Hazen Road to cul-de-sac)**
- **Jubilee Drive (Hazen Road to Town Hall Road)**
- **Leisure Court (Jubilee Drive to cul-de-sac)**
- **Marco Court (Hazen Road to cul-de-sac)**

BE IT RESOLVED, by the Village of Bellevue, Board of Trustees:

1. The Village Board hereby declares its intention to exercise its municipal power under §66.0703, Stats., to levy special assessments upon property in the assessment district hereafter described for benefits conferred upon such property by reason of the following public work and improvements:


Street resurfacing and curb repair
2. The property to be assessed lies within the following described assessment district:
 - **Casual Court (Jubilee Drive to cul-de-sac)**
 - **Collier Court (Hazen Road to cul-de-sac)**
 - **Jubilee Drive (Hazen Road to Town Hall Road)**
 - **Leisure Court (Jubilee Drive to cul-de-sac)**
 - **Marco Court (Hazen Road to cul-de-sac)**
3. The total amount assessed against properties in the described assessment district shall not exceed 100% of the total costs of the improvements.
4. The Village Board determines that the improvements constitute an exercise of municipal power for the health, safety and general welfare of the municipality and its inhabitants.
5. The Public Works Director shall have prepared a report consisting of the following:
 - a. Preliminary plans and specifications for the improvements.
 - b. An estimate of the entire cost of the proposed improvements.
 - c. A schedule of proposed assessments.
6. When the report is completed, the Director of Public Works shall file a copy of the report with the Village Clerk for public inspection.
7. Upon receipt of the Director of Public Work's report, the Clerk shall cause notice to be given stating the nature of the proposed improvements, the general boundary lines of the proposed Assessment District (to include a small map), the time and place at which the report may be inspected, and the time and place of the public hearing on the matters contained in the preliminary resolution and report. This notice shall be published as a


Class 1 notice under Ch. 985, Stats., and a copy shall be mailed 10 days in advance of the hearing to interested parties whose address is known or can be ascertained with reasonable diligence.

8. The hearing shall be held at a time set by the Clerk in accordance with §66.0703, Stats., at the Bellevue Village Hall, 3100 Eaton Road, Green Bay, Wisconsin.
9. The assessment against any parcel may be paid either in cash, or in ten (10) annual installments, plus interest at 1% above the Village's borrowing rate if the total assessed if over \$500; except that if any portion of any parcel is subsequently sold, subdivided for the purpose of sale or development, or if a *Request for Services* is applied for and granted through the Village, then any and all outstanding assessments for the entire parcel shall become due and immediately payable. Final allotment of special assessments shall be determined by the Village Board at the time of Public Hearing.
10. Adopted by the Bellevue Village Board this 12th day of December, 2018.


