FIRY-11 Transmission line rebuild project

## Dear Neighbor:

American Transmission Co. owns and operates the high-voltage electric transmission system in most of Wisconsin. To make needed improvements, we are rebuilding the 69,000 volt transmission line that crosses on or near your property.

Due to the age and condition of some parts of the transmission line facilities, we are in the process of developing a comprehensive plan to rebuild the line to 102 wood h-frames structures with steel monopoles. The roughly 11-mile line runs from the Finger Road Substation in the city of Green Bay to the Wesmark Substation in the town of Denmark (please see map on reverse side).

ATC and/or contractor staff may have been, and will continue to be, out on the right-of-way to gather additional information prior to construction, conduct vegetation management work and related-maintenance activities throughout 2021 and early 2022. We'll contact you for permission if we need access to your property outside the right-of-way. We anticipate construction will begin summer 2022.

## **COVID-19 precautions**

Safety is a priority for ATC. Our field workers and contractors continue to conduct their work according to the safe distancing practices recommended by the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention, and state public health guidelines.
