# **PROPOSAL DUE: March 31, 2021**VILLAGE OF BELLEVUE REQUEST FOR PROPOSAL

#### Design, Provide, and Install Automatic Gate

#### **BACKGROUND**

The Village of Bellevue is interested in the installation of an automatic gate and opener. The structure is to be installed at 3891 Eaton Road, Village of Bellevue Compost Site.

#### **SCOPE OF WORK**

The Village seeks to contract for the design, and installation of a metal frame 4' high (minimum) automatic gate with opener. The opener shall include, and operate on a timer, internal heater, and an exit loop. The Village will purchase the structure from the approved vendor. The desired location for placement of the structure will be located west of the ground berms as you enter the site. The ideal location is marked with orange wood laths. The gate bidders must be prepared to comply with all state, federal, and local requirements for permanent structures.

#### PROPOSER'S CLARIFICATION

By submitting a proposal, the proposer certifies that this request for bid has been fully read and that the proposer understands the proposal method. The bidder should have full knowledge of the scope, nature, and quality of work to be performed.

#### **PROPOSAL PROCESS**

The proposal process will consist of a written presentation. The following should be included in your written proposal:

- 1. A scaled drawing for the compost site showing proposed equipment, foundation/footings, and other necessary improvements to provide an automatic gate with opener. Design requirements for the site are attached. The bidder will be responsible for verifying exact conditions and dimensions in the field.
- 2. A breakdown cost of equipment; installation of equipment; foundation/footings; installation of foundation, and other necessary improvements as shown in the criteria for site or determined to be necessary by the contractor for a complete job.
- 3. Product warranty information
- 4. Product color schemes available with proposed equipment

#### STRUCUTRE REQUIREMENTS

The proposed structure must conform to and meet the following:

- Must have poured concrete foundations/footings
- Must abide by all local, state, and federal codes for permanent structures.
- Proposed gate should be a minimum of four feet in height

## IMPORTANT: COST PROPOSALS MUST LIST OUT COSTS AS DESCRIBED TO CLEARLY IDENTIFY COST BY ELEMENTS BELOW:

Equipment costs

- Foundation/footings cost
- Installation of equipment cost
- Installation of foundation/footings cost
- Cost of other site improvements required
- As an alternate, provide the cost difference if the Village completed any necessary excavating

#### **CONTRACTOR STATEMENT OF QUALIFICATIONS/EXPERIENCE**

A complete description of capability and history of the CONTRACTOR should be included. History of similar projects completed within the last three years, including project cost and client contact information.

#### **REFERENCES**

Proposals should include a brief history and introduction of the company or firm, and the firm's understanding of the services to be performed. Provide a list of at least three public references for whom have provided product/services similar to those proposed. References are to include agency, address, contact person, title, and phone number.

#### **EVALUATION OF PROPOSALS**

A panel of Village of Bellevue staff and representatives will review the written proposals. The Village will negotiate a final design and contract with the vendor rated first for the project. Overall responsiveness to the Request for Proposals is an important factor in the evaluation process.

Evaluation of proposals will be based on:

- Responsiveness to the RFP and the criteria for the site
- Equipment designs and concepts presented
- Originality and creativity
- Durability and ease of maintenance of the equipment proposed
- Ability to meet budget, although cost will not be the sole deciding factor
- Ability to put together a design and construction system which will be able to perform all aspects of the project
- Reasonableness of suggested schedule. Schedule should assume award of contract approximately thirty (30) days after oral presentation with submittal of necessary bonds and insurance following award before a notice to proceed is given

Final award will be made by the Village Board. No other officer or agent may obligate or bind the Village.

#### **PROPOSAL REJECTION**

The Village of Bellevue reserves the right to reject any or all proposals and to accept or reject any part of any proposal. It also reserves the right to waive any technical defects or minor irregularities, which in its discretion, is in the best interest of the Village.

#### **PROPOSAL DEADLINE**

The deadline for receiving proposals is 9:00am on March 31, 2021. Proposals should be signed by an authorized individual to bind the firm and must be valid for at least 90 days.
